WHSGA Honor Roll

Each year, the Wisconsin High School Gymnastics Association (WHSGA) recognizes the accomplishments of gymnasts across the state. The honor roll is published three times throughout the season. Round One recognition covers the period of Nov 11 to Dec 22, 2024. Round Two will include scores up to Jan 25, 2025, and Round Three will include scores through Feb 22, 2025.

In order to be placed on the honor roll, gymnasts must be on a high school team with at least one coach who is a member in good standing and meet one or more of the following criteria:

- 1. An individual event score of 7.800 or higher on the uneven bars.
- 2. An individual event score of 8.200 or higher on the vault, balance beam, or floor exercise.
- 3. An all-around score of 33.000 or higher.
- 4. Have not received any athletic code violations

The top ten total team scores, for which there is no minimum, are also recognized.

The WHSGA only recognizes gymnasts and teams whose scores have been submitted by their coaches.
